

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: Horizon Health Network Public Health and community

partners in the City of Saint John, County of St. John, Province of New Brunswick is concerned about the health

of its citizens; and

WHEREAS: it is estimated that between 500,000 and 600,000 people in

Canada are living with hepatitis B and C and are at risk of developing cirrhosis, liver failure, liver cancer and non-liver

related manifestations; and

WHEREAS: Hepatitis C is the most commonly reported blood borne

infection in NB; and

WHEREAS: there are vaccines available for Hepatitis A and B;

emerging Hepatitis C treatment therapies can cure nearly

95% of cases; and

WHEREAS: World Hepatitis Day provides an opportunity to reach out to

millions of Canadians and encourage hepatitis testing, provide treatment and care for those affected while paving the way towards elimination of hepatitis as a public health

concern in Canada by 2030.

NOW THEREFORE: I, Mayor Don Darling, of Saint John do hereby proclaim July 28, 2019, as Hepatitis Awareness Day, in the City of Saint John.
