### ***EXECUTIVE SUMMARY***

The purpose of this report is to inform Council of a Public Information Session that will be held in relation to the Cedarpoint Anchorage Neighbourhood - Plan for Traffic Calming and Asphalt Resurfacing and to update Council on the status of the project.

### ***PREVIOUS RESOLUTION***

November 28, 2016; Council Report – Cedarpoint Anchorage Neighbourhood – Plan for Resurfacing; Recommendation to receive and file adopted.

July 30, 2018; 2019 General Fund Capital Program Approved.

December 18, 2018; 2019 General Fund Operating Program Approved.

### ***REPORT***

The 2019 General Fund Operating Budget for Transportation and Environment Services and the 2019 General Fund Transportation Capital Program include provisions for the resurfacing of a number of streets in the City. This is an

annual program to upgrade and maintain deteriorating street surfaces under the maintenance and capital resurfacing programs.

Tenders for this work were closed on March 26, 2019 and the contract was awarded to the low-bidder, Galbraith Construction Ltd. The overall contract includes all work associated with the resurfacing of a total of 34 streets or segments of streets. Included in this contract was the allowance for the installation of a traffic calming circle on Cedarwood Drive at the Birchdale Crecent intersection along with the resurfacing of Cedarwood Drive, Birchdale Crescent and Rivershore Drive.

In addition to the traffic calming circle and the asphalt resurfacing work, other features will be incorporated on Cedarwood Drive intended to calm traffic and allow for safer pedestrian passage.

- A centerline and two white sidelines will be painted to delineate driving lanes
- A 1.5m wide pathway will be created on one side of the street to allow for safe pedestrian passage
- 'Rumble strips' will be milled into the asphalt surface to provide some additional separation of pedestrian and vehicle traffic

This is a significant project that will have an impact on the traffic flow through the local area during and after construction.

It is for this reason that staff have decided to hold a Public Information Session to allow local residents an opportunity to view the project design drawings, ask questions and give their feedback. The Public Information Session will be held at the Paroisse Saint-Francois-de-Sales Church at 77 Ragged Point Road on Thursday, August 22, from 2-4 p.m. and 6-8 p.m. This report is being provided for the information of Council and to extend an invitation to any Councillors who may wish to attend the Public Information Session.

The Public Information Session will be advertised on the City's website and copies of the attached notice will be delivered door to door in project area.

### ***STRATEGIC ALIGNMENT***

This report aligns with Council's Priority for Valued Service Delivery, specifically as it relates to investing in sustainable City services and municipal infrastructure.
