Taskforce

Special Events Taskforce

The SETF is comprised of representatives from various service areas working to provide information and assistance regarding event policies, procedures, and best practices to community groups hosting large-scale events.

To date, the Special Events Taskforce has received, reviewed, and processed 27 Special Event Applications for local organizers to ensure events are appropriately supported and safe for all to enjoy.





Celebrate Canada

In 2024, the City of Saint John was once again successful in receiving funding (\$33,500) from Canadian Heritage through the *Celebrate Canada Fund*.

Funds received were used to support three (3) key initiatives:

- National Indigenous Peoples Day June 2
- o Canadian Multiculturalism Day June 27
- Canada Day Celebrations July 1





Passport to Parks

The Passport to Parks event series supports Council's priority of 'belonging' by delivering high-quality programming aimed at enriching the health and well-being of all Saint John residents.

The City is scheduled to host (4) signature Passport to Parks events in 2024:

- Dominion Park New Resident Welcome Event July 13
- o Rockwood Park Accessibility-Focused Event July 17
- Little River Reservoir August 10
- o Lily Lake August 31





Night Market

The Saint John Night Market highlights local creators and curators throughout the summer. Featuring artisanal products, live music, cultural performances, and culinary delights from around the world, the Night Market is a cherished event hosted annually.

The Saint John Night Market will take place every Thursday, July 4 - August 29, with vendors positioned indoors and out, as well as several activations throughout the site, and the return of the Compass Lounge.
