5 Contributing Factors

- 1. No formal City approval process
- 2. Unaware of entity responsible for work
- 3. Inadequate communications plan
- 4. Challenging regulatory environment
- 5. Harbour Bridge lane closures



5 Actions to Improve

- 1. City approval process (immediate)
- 2. Improved public communications
- 3. Improved regulations
- 4. Railways attend pre-construction season meetings
- 5. Expedite Harbour Bridge project
