## ***PROCLAMATION***


***WHEREAS:*** every year nearly one thousand Canadian workers are killed by workplace injuries and many more die from occupational disease; and

***WHEREAS:*** thousands more are permanently disabled; and

***WHEREAS:*** tens of thousands are injured or made ill; and

***WHEREAS:*** concerned Canadians are determined to prevent these tragedies by:

- Observing April 28<sup>th</sup> as a day of mourning to remember these victims of workplace injuries and disease;
- Renewing our efforts to seek stronger safety and health protections, better standards and enforcement, and fair and just compensations; and
- Rededicating ourselves to improving safety and health in every Canadian workplace.

***NOW THEREFORE:*** I, ***Mayor Don Darling,***  of ***Saint John*** do hereby proclaim April 28, 2019, as a “Day of Mourning” in recognition of workers killed, injured or disabled on the job.
