Overwatch 2019 – SJEMO Activated

- Still at Level 1
- Level 3



River Watch 2010 – Home Impact

- 248 homes isolated by flood water
- 75 homes impacted



River Watch 2010 – SJ ENERGY

- 19 Properties disconnected
- 10 Properties remain disconnected



- 68 Families Registered
- Canadian Red Cross provided lodging for 14 SJ families / 32 people at peak
- 9 SJ Families / 24 people still be housed by Canadian Red Cross



- T & E Services filled 30,900 sandbags
- Distributed 24,197 sandbags
- 6,703 sandbags to be shrink wrapped and stored



sandbags = Holding back the River

This is resiliency & the power of the sandbag

Photos were taken 4 hours apart on the same day, at the same flood level

River Watch 2016 – Roads

- 14 Roads were closed
- 2 Roads build up
- All Roads opened as of 3pm this afternoon



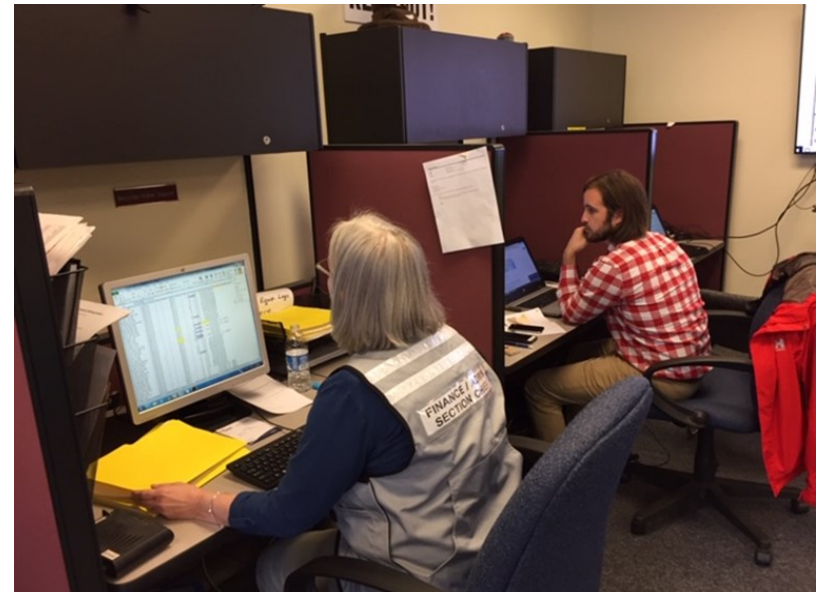
River Watch 2016 – Parks

- 8 Parks are closed
- Contamination from Flood Water
- Assessed later this week or next week

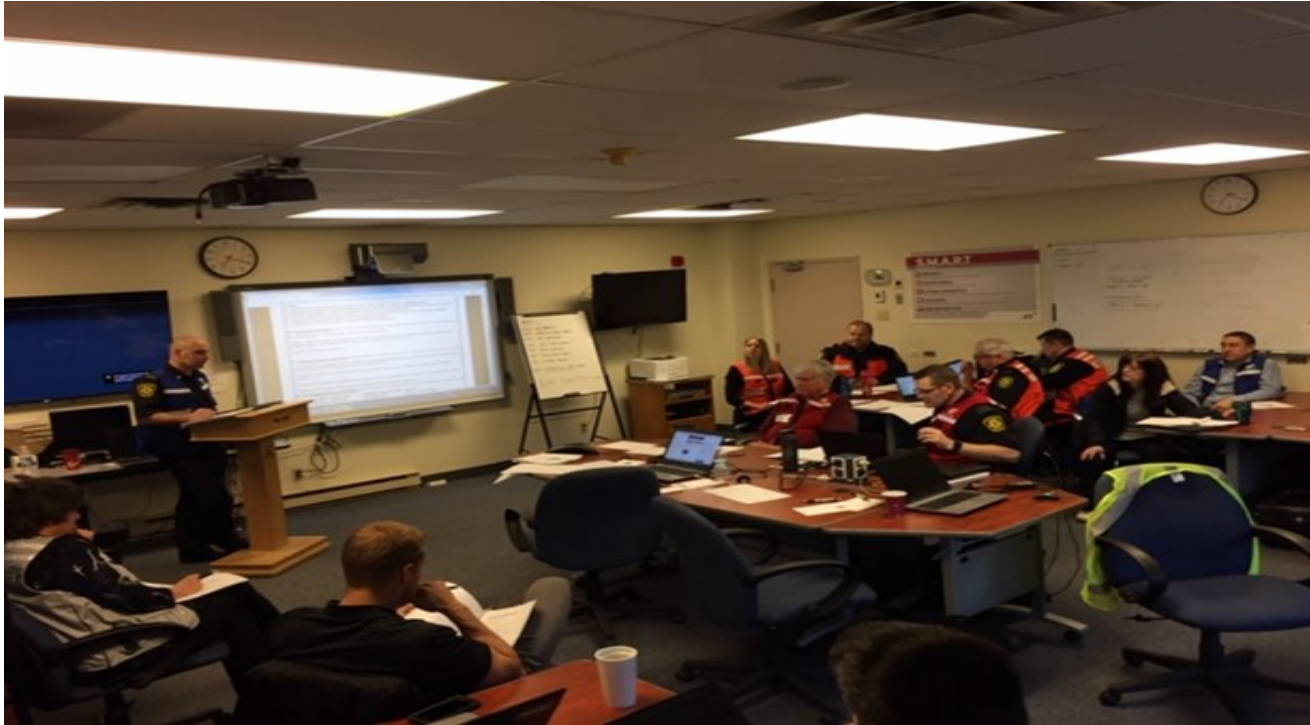
Riverwatch 2019 – Volunteers
